Celebrating Subang

DPI Holdings Bhd recently launched the Beautify Subang Project, kickstarting it with an uplifting mural on a building façade.

The mural, one of the largest to be found in Subang, was illustrated by acclaimed British artist Gabriel Pitcher and took over 15 days to be completed.

Created under the theme "Change", the mural depicts a young lady looking at her reflection representing both her older and newer self.

In the illustration, the newer self is depicted as facing the mirror reflection and is represented by more vibrant colours. These pronounced colours signify her transformed self as she continues to improve herself.

Meanwhile, the older self which is portrayed with her back facing the spectator is repre-

sented by lighter, desaturated colours.

"The year 2019 is one of change for us. We began the year with a successful listing on the ACE Market and in our bid to continue this momentum of transformation, we have embarked on a Beautify Subang Project which aims to transform the cityscape," says DPI executive chairman and managing director Peter Chai.
